- Innovative and entrepreneurial approach, able to develop and create solutions to complex issues.
- Position requires absolute confidentiality and professionalism in appearance, attitude and presentation.
- A self-starter with the ability to work productively and meet benchmarks and goals in a timely manner and without day-to-day supervision.

Education & Experience

- Proven track record in successful nonprofit fundraising & advancement experience, ideally in an international school setting.
- Master's (or higher) degree preferable.
